

Cornerstone Courts Hoops 2U Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. Promoter

1.1 The promoter of this competition is **Cornerstone Courts Pty Ltd** (ABN/ACN: 12 676 727 398) of **26/42 McArthurs Road Altona North VIC 3025** ("Promoter").

1.2 These Terms and Conditions apply to the **Cornerstone Courts Hoops 2U Competition** ("Competition").

2. Competition Period

2.1 The Competition commences at **12:00am AEST on 1 September 2026** and closes at **11:59pm AEST on 24 December 2026** ("Competition Period").

2.2 Purchases made outside the Competition Period are not eligible for entry.

3. Eligibility

3.1 Entry is open to Australian residents who:

- (a) reside in **Queensland or Victoria**; and
- (b) are aged **18 years or over** at the time of entry; and
- (c) reside within 100 kilometres of Brisbane or Melbourne

3.2 Employees of Cornerstone Courts Pty Ltd, its related companies, agencies directly involved in the Competition, and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter.

3.3 The Promoter reserves the right to request reasonable evidence of an entrant's identity, age, residential address and qualifying purchase.

4. How to Enter

4.1 To automatically receive one entry into the Competition, an eligible entrant must purchase a **new basketball court from Cornerstone Courts** during the Competition Period.

4.2 The purchase must be accepted and confirmed by Cornerstone Courts during the Competition Period.

4.3 Each qualifying court purchase constitutes **one entry** into the Competition.

4.4 If an eligible entrant purchases more than one qualifying basketball court during the Competition Period, each separate qualifying purchase constitutes one separate entry.

4.5 There is no separate entry fee for the Competition.

4.6 An order that is cancelled, refunded, terminated or otherwise not completed may be deemed ineligible by the Promoter.

4.7 The Promoter reserves the right to verify all entries and qualifying purchases before awarding the Prize.

5. The Prize

5.1 There will be **one (1) winner**.

5.2 The winner will receive a **Hoops 2U Arcade Staffed package** ("Prize").

5.3 The Prize includes:

- (a) **Arcade basketball games only**;
- (b) **transport and setup** of the arcade equipment; and
- (c) **NBA 2K gaming station**; and
- (d) **one (1) staff member** to assist with the Hoops 2U experience.

5.4 The Prize has a value of:

\$1,497 including GST for a weekday booking; or

\$1,947 including GST for a weekend booking.

5.5 The maximum advertised Prize value is **\$1,947 including GST**, based on the weekend rate.

5.6 The Prize does not include any Hoops 2U services, equipment or inclusions that are not specifically stated in clause 5.3.

5.7 The Prize does not include, unless expressly agreed in writing:

- (a) a 3x3 basketball court;
- (b) additional entertainment or arcade equipment;
- (c) venue hire;
- (d) catering, food or beverages;

- (e) accommodation;
- (f) additional staff;
- (g) additional event days; or
- (h) additional travel, transport or other costs outside the standard Prize offering.

5.8 The Prize is for **one event/day**.

5.9 The Prize cannot be exchanged for cash or substituted for another product or service, except where required by law or otherwise determined by the Promoter.

5.10 The Prize cannot be sold, transferred or on-sold.

6. Weekday or Weekend Prize

6.1 The winner may request either a weekday or weekend booking, subject to availability.

6.2 A weekday booking has a stated value of **\$1,497 including GST**.

6.3 A weekend booking has a stated value of **\$1,947 including GST**.

6.4 The winner will not receive the difference between the weekday and weekend value if they choose a weekday booking.

6.5 The maximum Prize value available to the winner is **\$1,947 including GST**.

7. Prize Location

7.1 The winner must nominate a suitable location for the Hoops 2U experience.

7.2 The nominated location must be within the standard Hoops 2U service area and approved by Hoops 2U.

7.3 The nominated location must have suitable access, space, ground conditions and other requirements reasonably necessary for the safe delivery, setup and operation of the arcade equipment.

7.4 The winner is responsible for obtaining any necessary permission from the venue owner, property owner, council or other relevant authority.

7.5 Additional travel, transport or other charges may apply if the nominated location is outside the standard Hoops 2U service area. Any such additional costs are the responsibility of the winner unless otherwise agreed in writing.

8. Prize Booking

8.1 The winner must contact Cornerstone Courts/Hoops 2U to arrange the Prize.

8.2 The Prize must be booked in advance and is subject to availability.

8.3 The Promoter will make reasonable efforts to accommodate the winner's preferred date but does not guarantee that any particular date will be available.

8.4 The Prize must be redeemed by **31/12/2027**, unless otherwise agreed by the Promoter in writing.

8.5 If the winner cancels a confirmed booking without reasonable notice, the Promoter may, at its discretion, offer an alternative available date.

9. Draw

9.1 One (1) winner will be selected by random draw from all eligible entries received during the Competition Period.

9.2 The draw will take place on **11th January 2027** at **9am AEDST** at **Via ELECTRONIC DRAW METHOD**.

9.3 Each eligible entry will have an equal chance of being selected.

9.4 The winner does not need to be present at the time of the draw.

9.5 The Promoter may appoint an independent person to conduct or witness the draw.

10. Notification of Winner

10.1 The winner will be contacted using the contact details provided to Cornerstone Courts at the time of purchase.

10.2 The winner will be notified within **two (2) business days** of the draw.

10.3 The winner may be announced on the Cornerstone Courts website and/or Cornerstone Courts social media channels, subject to applicable privacy requirements.

10.4 The winner must respond to the Promoter within **seven (7) days** of being notified.

10.5 If the winner cannot be contacted after reasonable attempts, fails to respond within the required period, is found to be ineligible or otherwise fails to comply with these Terms and Conditions, the Promoter may conduct a redraw.

11. Redraw

11.1 If a redraw is required, the Promoter will conduct a further random draw from the remaining eligible entries.

11.2 The redraw will take place on **19th January 2027** at **9am AEDST** at **Via ELECTRONIC DRAW METHOD**.

11.3 The redraw winner will be subject to the same eligibility and verification requirements as the original winner.

12. Safety

12.1 The winner and all participants must comply with reasonable safety instructions provided by Hoops 2U personnel.

12.2 Hoops 2U personnel may suspend, modify or terminate the Hoops 2U experience if they reasonably believe that the equipment, venue, weather conditions or participants present a safety risk.

12.3 The Promoter and Hoops 2U reserve the right to refuse installation or operation of the equipment at a location that is considered unsuitable or unsafe.

13. Changes to the Competition

13.1 Subject to applicable law, the Promoter reserves the right to modify, suspend, postpone or cancel the Competition where circumstances beyond its reasonable control make this necessary.

13.2 If the Competition is modified, suspended or cancelled, the Promoter will provide reasonable notice through its website or other appropriate communication channels.

13.3 The Promoter will not exercise this right for the purpose of unfairly disadvantaging an entrant.

14. Privacy

14.1 Personal information collected in connection with the Competition will be handled in accordance with the Promoter's Privacy Policy.

14.2 Personal information may be collected and used for the purposes of administering the Competition, verifying entries, contacting entrants and arranging delivery of the Prize.

14.3 By entering the Competition, entrants consent to the Promoter using their personal information for purposes reasonably necessary to administer the Competition.

14.4 The winner consents to the Promoter using the winner's name for the purpose of announcing the winner, including on the Cornerstone Courts website and social media channels, where permitted by law.

15. Disqualification

15.1 The Promoter may disqualify an entrant if it reasonably believes that the entrant:

- (a) has breached these Terms and Conditions;
- (b) has provided false or misleading information;

(c) has attempted to manipulate or interfere with the Competition or draw process;

(d) has engaged in fraudulent conduct; or

(e) is otherwise not eligible to enter.

15.2 The Promoter's decision regarding eligibility and the conduct of the Competition is final, subject to any rights available to entrants under applicable law.

16. Australian Consumer Law

16.1 Nothing in these Terms and Conditions excludes, restricts or modifies any rights, guarantees or remedies that cannot lawfully be excluded, restricted or modified under the **Australian Consumer Law**.

16.2 Subject to clause 16.1, the Promoter and Hoops 2U are not responsible for any loss, damage, delay or inconvenience arising from circumstances beyond their reasonable control.

17. General

17.1 By entering the Competition, entrants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

17.2 If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is found to be invalid or unenforceable, that provision will be severed to the extent necessary and the remaining provisions will continue to apply.

17.3 These Terms and Conditions should be read together with any promotional material published by Cornerstone Courts in relation to the Competition.

17.4 Where there is an inconsistency between promotional material and these Terms and Conditions, these Terms and Conditions will prevail to the extent of the inconsistency.
